What Do You Want To Be Remembered For?

Nehemiah 13

Pastor Johnson reviewed the fact that a survey of 95 year old men said that one of the things they would change about their life would be to “do more things that live on.” This statement brings us to Nehemiah 13:31b where Nehemiah states the same thing as a prayer to God. Our discussion this weekend was to answer the question, “what kind of life is remembered?” Pastor gave us five ideas which were seen in Nehemiah’s book:

- We were a people who captured God’s vision for our lives and were passionate about it.
- We were a people who lived our vision out of prayer.
- We were a people who took the risk to go after it and build the wall.
- We were a people who withstood and overcame the opposition.
- We were a people zealous for the things of God.

Passion is what launches our faith and keeps us going against mediocrities gravitational pull.
