When God's Plans Make No Sense
Hebrews 11:30; Joshua 6:1-20

Joshua, as commander of the army of Israel, fought his first battle at Jericho. God planned an unorthodox strategy to bring down Jericho, one that would require a huge step of faith for Joshua to believe and follow.

For Joshua to have the faith needed to follow God would require him to ...

- A. Embrace God's vision.
- B. Claim God's promises
- C. Submit to God's mysteries.
