Psalm 95

Questions for Discussion:

1. Read Psalm 95. What do you see in the passage or recall from the sermon that is interesting or helpful to you?
2. Do you recall the definition of Worship that Pastor Dean gave?
3. Which statements in Psalm 95 indicate our worship is to be "Vocal" (or "Out Loud")?

How do we apply this? (How is our worship "out loud"?)

4. Worship is Response to Who God is, and What He has done. What statements in Psalm 95 point back to God?
5. Verse 6 indicates a couple of body postures while worshipping. Dean also mentioned numerous other body postures? List some of our possible physical expressions in response to God.

How is *your* worship "physical"?
How comfortable are you with different physical expressions in worship,
for
yourself and for others?

6. The final section of the Psalm gives a warning. What is the warning and why was it given? What happened at Meribah and Massah? (See Exodus 17:7)
How is this related to worship?

7. The Clipboard Assignment this week is:

- A. Be in Scripture this week ... listening to God
- B. Be in Prayer this week ... responding to God
- C. Come ready for awesome corporate worship the following weekend.
