Ephesians 4:25

6. Is your personal confidence, identity, and value found in the gospel – knowing that you are at the same time more wicked than you realize, and more loved than you will ever know?
7. Are there changes that need to be made in your life where this lifegroup can partner with you to help you become a more honest and truthful person?
